



Equal Employment Opportunity Policy

The Foundation of HOPE is committed to providing a non-discriminatory employment environment for its employees.

The policy of the Foundation of HOPE is to fully comply with applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations in the area of non-discrimination in employment. Discrimination against employees and applicants due to race, color, religion, sex (including sexual harassment), national origin, disability, age (40 years or older), military and veteran status is prohibited. Violations of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including termination.
